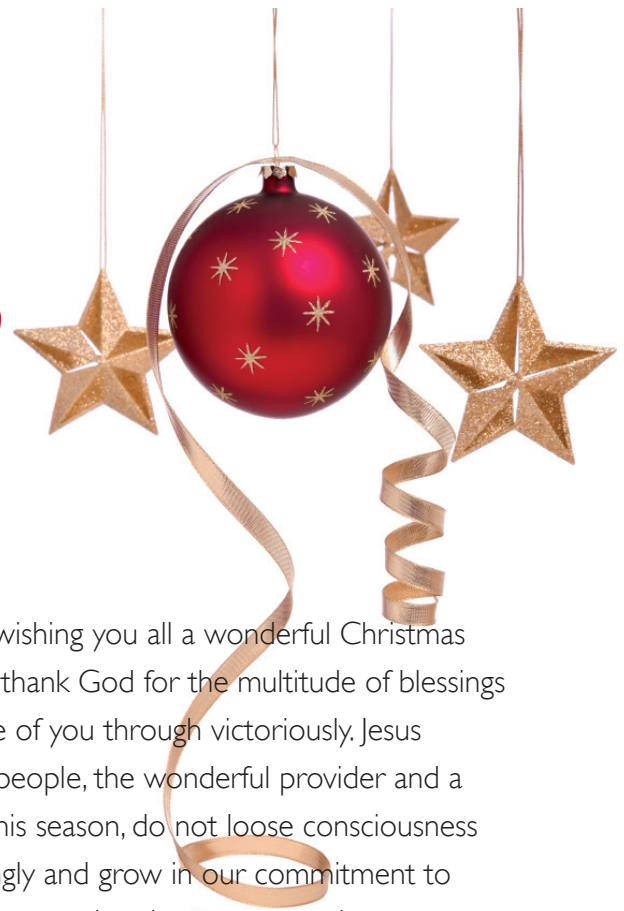


Merry Christmas and Glorious New Year 2010
